

Water features worth visiting in Warsaw.

PSNWK highly recommended to visit these places instead of common tourist trips in the capital of Poland.

1. Grzybowski Square

A square with a nice decorative pond and fountain that works as an oxygen supply. Nearby you can find old tenement houses.



2, Europe square, surrounded by modern buildings. A meeting place for local citizens. A few water features: ponds, fountains, streams.



3. New Vistula boulevards. On one coast there's a new promenade, on the opposite one, there's a natural river coast, a forest with natural paths.



4. Warsaw University Library green roof.



One of the biggest green roofs in Europe, more than 5 000 sqm of green surface (total sqm 10 000).

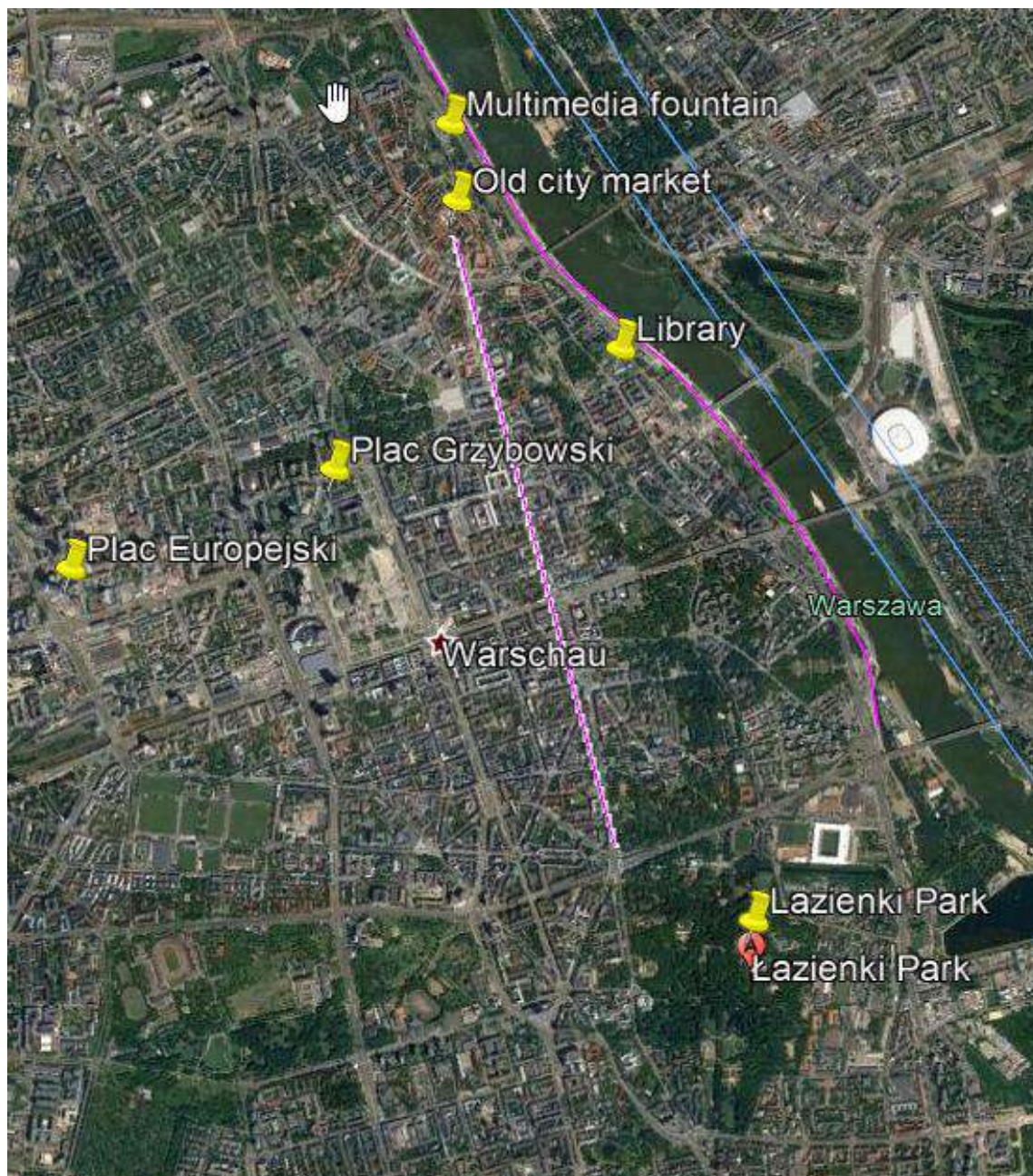
5. Multimedia fountain with about 2800 m² water surface and 3 ponds



6. Łazienki Królewskie- Royal Bath Park



Water - palace complex from 18 century in the centre of the city - Łazienki Królewskie. It contains a park (80 ha) and an impressive number of historical buildings.
